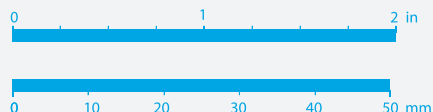


Please follow all instructions carefully as the measurement may not be accurate if not done properly.

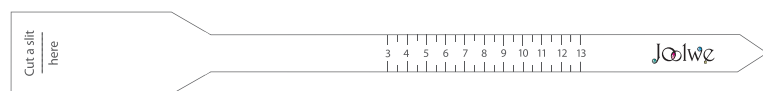
CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE



1. Before printing, ensure that page scaling is set to "none" on your print dialog box. If there is a thin gray border on your print out, then page scaling is most likely still on.
2. With a ruler, confirm the bar on the left to ensure it is exactly 2 inches, or 50mm long.
3. If measurement is not accurate, make sure the page was printed at full size and reprint.

METHOD 1 - Measure Finger Using Paper Sizer

- Cut along the outline of the sizer. Make a slit in the left, flat end of the sizer.
- Wrap the intended finger with the sizer with the numbers facing out.
- Slide the pointed end of the sizer pass through the slit.
- Before pulling, move the sizer to the largest part of the finger, possibly the knuckle.
- Pull tightly. The sizer must fit tightly to produce accurate result.
- The number that lines up at the slit represents the ring size for that finger.

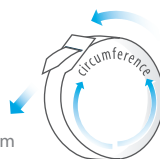


FOR ACCURATE MEASUREMENT

- Avoid measuring cold fingers when fingers are at their smallest.
- Measure your fingers at the end of the day when they are at their largest.

RING SIZE TO MILLIMETER (Circumference)

METHOD 2 - Measure an Existing Ring

- Choose a ring that fits the finger you are purchasing the ring for. If you are selecting a ring for your traditional "ring finger", note that it is located between your middle and pinky finger. In the United States, the engagement and wedding rings are worn on the ring finger of the left hand.
- Place the rings over the circles below until you find one that matches the inside edge of your ring accurately. The measurement represents the diameter of the ring.
- If the ring is in between two sizes, choose the larger size.
